- The soft copy of the photos with the details and a Photocopy of College ID card should be mailed to vidyarthijignasa@gmail.com

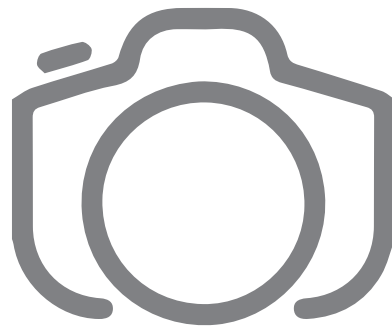
JURY: Eminent persons including Nature and Wildlife photography
